7. Sun Shade Update (Dawn Shippe)

- 1) The grant application to the American Academy of Dermatologists for \$8,000 was submitted in mid-December. This will cover the full cost of a new umbrella but is a national competition. We will hear by the end of March.
- 2) The matching grant program run by the city of Arvada is being overhauled and its future is unclear at present. This award would have matched the \$4,000 voted on by the PTA last April to pay for an umbrella. Currently in communication with the new program director and hope to have more questions answered, but at this point, it looks unlikely that any awards will be made in the near future. These changes may impact the track upgrade proposal as well.
